United States Embassy, Dhaka, Bangladesh Security Message for U.S. Citizens

Nationwide Strike or Hartal called for Thursday, November 30, 2017

According to local news sources, the Communist Party of Bangladesh (CPB), Bangladesh Samajtantrik (BSD), and other left-leaning political parties have called for a six-hour nationwide hartal on Thursday, November 30, from 6 a.m. to 12 noon in reaction to nationwide electricity price hikes.

The U.S. Embassy informs U.S. citizens that the hartals are expected to take place throughout Dhaka Thursday, November 30, from 6 a.m. to 12 noon. However, local experience has shown that hartal organizers and supporters often begin their protests the night before a hartal is scheduled to commence. As a result, extra caution and vigilance should be exercised from Wednesday, November 29 beginning at 6 p.m. and should continue until 12 noon, Thursday, November 30.

In Bangladesh, a hartal is a mass protest and recognized political method for articulating a political demand. A hartal may or may not affect local transportation services, schools, shopping malls, and infrastructure. Extra caution and vigilance should be taken to avoid large crowds and protests. As always, be aware of your surroundings at all times. Even demonstrations intended to be peaceful can turn confrontational and escalate into violence. You should avoid areas of demonstrations, and exercise caution if in the vicinity of any large gatherings, protests, or demonstrations.
